While personal electronic devices that contain such batteries -- e.g., laptops, tablets, cellphones -- are still permitted in checked bags as long as ...

Lithium metal batteries installed in a device can be transported as checked or carry-on baggage. Lithium metal batteries not installed in a device (spares) are only permitted as carry-on baggage.

The safest and most recommended way to travel with a power tool is to remove the battery and pack it in your carry-on baggage while checking the tool. The regulated part of a power tool is ...

Yes, you can have power tool batteries in your checked luggage. However, you should pack them in a separate, sealed bag and place them in the bottom of your suitcase.

Power tools must be packed in checked bags, including drills and drill bits. Power tools with installed batteries must be packed in checked bags. ...

If you are bringing power tools any spare or loose lithium-ion batteries cannot be packed in checked baggage and must be packed in carry ...

Spare (uninstalled) lithium metal batteries and lithium ion batteries, electronic cigarettes and vaping devices are prohibited in checked baggage. They must be carried with the passenger in carry-on ...

Since some devices use lithium ion batteries, you cannot travel with them in your checked bags. You can travel with them in your carry-on, but you're not allowed to use them on board any flight.
