I have a CD that's created from an ISO file which I use to install a custom version of Ubuntu via Plop Linux. The CD works fine but I'd like to use a bootable USB drive instead. I used the command ...

I suppose you could try and create an ISO out of it, then use Rufus, to create a bootable installation media but that is more work, then simply downloading a valid bootable ISO from Microsoft ...

In the past I used ImgBurn to create ISO files from bootable cd/dvd disks. I can see that ImgBurn can be used to create ISO files from bootable usb sticks too.

I'm looking to create a bootable USB memory stick. However the USB stick has data that I can't afford to delete. If I were to burn an iso image on it the ordinary way, say with Ultraiso, the data w...

A bootable ISO is created, but, on its own, cannot be used to boot from - it first must be written to a storage device (USB / HDD) or VHD. The Windows installer ISO is WinPE (Windows ...

I have searched for some tools to create bootable USB sticks (Unetbootin, Rufus, make_me_bootable among others). But either they weren't able to create a bootable USB stick at all, ...

What's the best way of placing a bootable ISO on a USB drive, such that the drive is bootable? ISOs such as a live Linux preview disk, Windows installation ISO, etc.

I would like to create a bootable .iso from this USB drive so I can burn multiple copies of it to pass around to friends! I've created an iso using Folder2ISO, but it coastered my DVD because it wasn't ...
